

How To Get Your Driver's License With Parkway Driving School

1. Sign up with TDLR for your parent taught guide. This allows you to do the parent taught driver's ed. Scroll to the bottom of the home page and look for the link that says "TDLR". There will be a \$20 fee associated with this.
2. Register with Parkway Driving School by clicking the link that says, "Teach me how to drive" at the top or click the link that says, "Register" at the bottom of the home page. **You have 6 months to complete the program once you have signed up.**
3. Fill out all the required information on the "Register" page. This information will be kept private and not shared. This information will automatically fill out your Certificate. It also provides us your information in the act we may need to contact you.
4. Choose which program you want to do with Parkway Driving School. Scroll to the bottom of the home page to choose a program that suits you and your student. We recommend doing the online 32 hours of classroom and then driving with Parkway Driving School (depends on where you are located for availability of driving services).
5. Once you register, you will have an account with Parkway and will be able to make a payment. Pay the full amount of your program in order to be in an, 'Active Status' (this allows you to begin your driver's education program).
6. If you choose to do the online classroom and the drive times with us, sign up and call Coach Williams at 214-668-3749 for availability.
7. Begin your driver's education program. Once you have completed Day 3, you will be able to print your DE 964 by clicking the tab "Print Your Certificate For Learner's License," in your account page. Take this to the DPS/DMV to take the written test and eye exam to obtain your Learner's Permit.
8. Once you have obtained your Learner's Permit, you may now begin your drive times with Parkway Driving School or your Parent. You are able to log drive hours in conjunction with completing the rest of the online classroom days.
9. After completion of BOTH the 32 Hours of Online Classroom (16 days) AND the drive times, you may print your final certificate. If the parent conducts all the drive times, then they must fill out the top portion of the DE 964. If Parkway or another Driver's Education provider does the drive times, then they will be responsible for filling out the top portion.
10. Within 3 months of course completion, you must schedule the final driving test through the DPS/DMV.
11. When you go to the DPS/DMV for your final driving test, you will need the following: A new Verification of Enrollment (VOE Form) from your high school, \$11 to pay for the driving test, a driver's log sheet that is either filled out by the parent or driver's ed provider, followed by a parent or legal guardian being present.
12. Once you pass your drivers test you will receive your license.
